Re: Year 2020 Pentathlon CDD Report

Dear Ms. Nguyen:

The intent of this report is fourfold: 1) To inform as to the status of ownership of the infrastructure that was financed or constructed by the District; 2) To describe the state, working order and condition of the infrastructure still owned by the District; 3) To give recommendations as to the funds estimated necessary for the proper maintenance, repair and operation of the District's infrastructure and; 4) To review the insurance carried by the District and amounts set aside for the purpose of paying their premiums.

The District is in Section 20, Township 55S, Range 39E, in Miami-Dade County. It is bounded on the east by SW 157 Avenue; on the west by SW 158 Path; on the south by theoretical SW 148 Street; and on the north, by the Seaboard Airline Railroad Right of Way. The development may be accessed from the south by SW 152 Street (Coral Reef Drive) and SW 157 Avenue and from the west by SW 144 Street. See Exhibit 1 for a graphical representation of the development.

1. Infrastructure Ownership

a. Roads

All avenues, courts, places, paths, passages, terraces, streets and lanes within the District were dedicated to Miami-Dade County for the perpetual use of the public. This was accomplished by recording the "Milon Venture" plat on August 6, 2002 at Miami-Dade County Plat Book 159, Page 2.

b. Stormwater Drainage System

The road drainage system was dedicated to Miami-Dade County for the perpetual use of the public by the recording of the plat described above.

c. Water Distribution and Sanitary Sewer Systems

The water distribution and sanitary sewer systems were conveyed to Miami-Dade County for ownership and maintenance on December 6, 2002 under Agreement No. 17771.

2. State, Working Order and Condition of the Infrastructure Currently Owned or Maintained by the District

No public infrastructure is currently owned or maintained by the District since it was conveyed to the County as indicated above.

a. *Roads*

The roads, which are all owned by Miami-Dade County, are in fair condition, with the pavement markings fading. The pavement marking deficiencies have been reported online to the Miami-Dade County Department of Public Works and Waste Management at the link below. The County issued the following number to the report: 20-10418301.

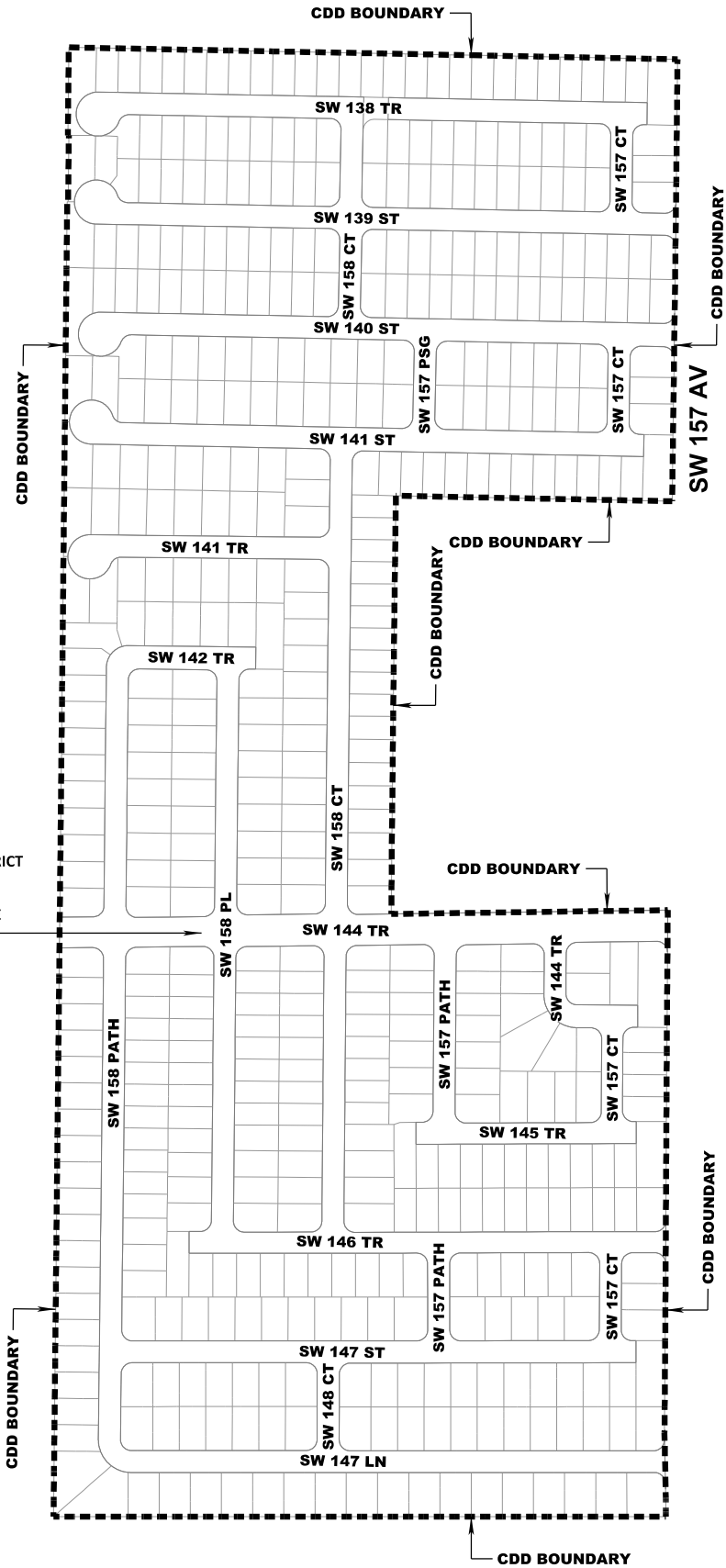
