

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#### PENTATHLON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING APRIL 16, 2025

#### A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Nancy Nguyen called the April 16, 2025, Regular Board Meeting of the Pentathlon Community Development District (the "District") to order at 6:23 p.m. in the Kendall Executive Center Second Floor Conference Room located at 8785 SW 165 Avenue, Suite 200, Miami, Florida 33193.

#### **B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION**

Ms. Nguyen presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Miami Herald* on September 30, 2024, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Regular Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

#### C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Ms. Nguyen determined that the attendance of Chairwoman Grissobelle Reyes-Obando, Vice Chairman Andre Goins, and Supervisors Michael Hunt and Julio Obando constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Staff in attendance included: District Manager Nancy Nguyen of Special District Services, Inc.; and District Counsel Liza Smoker of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.

#### D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

#### E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments for items not on the agenda.

#### F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

#### 1. November 20, 2024, Regular Board Meeting

Ms. Nguyen presented the November 20, 2024, Regular Board Meeting minutes and asked if there were any comments and/or changes.

There being no changes and/or comments, a **motion** was made by Ms. Reyes-Obando, seconded by Mr. Obando and unanimously passed approving the November 20, 2024, Regular Board Meeting minutes, as presented.

#### G. OLD BUSINESS

#### 1. Staff Report, as Required

There was no staff report at this time.

#### H. NEW BUSINESS

#### 1. Consider Resolution No. 2025-01 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Proposed Budget

Ms. Nguyen presented Resolution No. 2025-01, entitled:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE PENTATHLON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET AND NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Nguyen explained that the proposed 2025/2026 fiscal year budget would be balanced by designating a carryover of approximately \$10,320 from the \$240,000 projected fund balance as of September 30, 2025. Ms. Nguyen advised that since the overall proposed assessments were not increasing in the fiscal year 2025/2026, letters to the residents would not be required. Furthermore, Ms. Nguyen stated as part of Resolution No. 2025-01, the Board must set a date for the public hearing to adopt the fiscal year 2025/2026 final budget and assessment roll. A discussion ensued after which:

A **motion** was made by Reyes-Obando, seconded by Mr. Hunt and unanimously passed to approve and adopt Resolution No. 2025-01, *as presented*, setting the public hearing to adopt the fiscal year 2025/2026 final budget and assessments for <u>June 18, 2025 at 6:00 p.m.</u> in the Kendall Executive Center Second Floor Conference Room located at 8785 SW 165 Avenue, Suite 200, Miami, Florida 33193; and further authorizes publication/notice of the budget public hearing, as required by law.

#### 2. Consider Resolution No. 2025-02 – Registered Agent Change

Ms. Nguyen presented Resolution No. 2025-02, entitled:

#### **RESOLUTION 2025-02**

A RESOLUTION OF THE PENTATHLON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING MICHAEL J. PAWELCZYK AS THE DISTRICT'S REGISTERED AGENT AND DESIGNATING THE OFFICE OF BILLING, COCHRAN, LYLES, MAURO & RAMSEY, P.A. AS THE REGISTERED OFFICE

Ms. Smoker explained that Florida Statutes requires that the District designate a registered office and registered agent for the purpose of accepting service of process, notice, or demand that is required by law to be served upon the District. She further explained that it is necessary to designate a new registered agent and update the business address of the registered office.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Goins, seconded by Ms. Reyes-Obando and unanimously passed designating Michael J. Pawelczyk as the Pentathlon Community Development District registered agent, and designating the registered office at Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A., 515 East Las Olas Boulevard, Suite 600, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301.

Board members were reminded of the importance of electronically completing their individual 2024 Statement of Financial Interests Form 1 through the Florida Commission on Ethics Electronic Financial Disclosure Management System (EFDMS). The deadline for submittal is July 1, 2025. Ms. Nguyen also noted that the Board members were required to confirm that they completed their individual four-hour ethics training by December 31, 2025, when completing the form.
